

From Wrecsam to Cardigan, Bangor to Newport, anti war direct action, rallies, vigils and public meetings organised by individuals, anti-war groups, communities and religious organisations continue to take place all over Wales. As the war story in the media changes ,our message remains constant in time of atrocity or interim 'peace': without true justice there will be no true peace. It is important that our message calling for justice is heard consistently and clearly. We must each act to inspire and empower others to act and to see war and all violence for what it is - a product of a militarist culture and a history of oppressive injustices.

- * CND Cymru wholeheartedly condemns terrorist atrocities anywhere in the world.
Nothing can justify these terrible crimes.
- * We oppose military retaliation against Afghanistan, Iraq or any other countries. War can not and will not reduce the risks of terrorist attacks. The root causes of terrorism must be addressed. Violence breeds violence. War and preparation for war cause massive environmental damage, increase the sense of injustice felt by the oppressed and disempowered world wide and create a fertile environment for terrorist recruitment. Real security for all people of the world can only come from justice, co-operation, understanding and respect and not from ever mounting military expenditure.
- * We believe that the United States and Britain should proceed on the basis of international law, following the UN Charter, and working through the normal channels of extradition law, to bring the perpetrators of any atrocities to justice. The process of law, not the process of war would be a far more intelligent solution.
- * There must be an end to anti-Muslim attacks and prejudice and an active programme to encourage understanding between groups and individuals within Wales and worldwide.
- * We reject the erosion of our civil liberties in the name of anti-terrorism.
We cannot defend freedom by destroying it.
- * We are committed to campaigning against this 'war' solely by non-violent means.





O Wrecsam i Aberteifi, Bangor i Gasnewydd, mae gweithredoedd uniongyrchol yn erbyn y rhyfel, raliau, gwylnosau a chyfarfodydd cyhoeddus wedi eu trefnu gan unigolion, grwpiau gwrth-ryfel, cymunedau a mudiadau crefyddol yn dal i ddigwydd ledled Cymru. Wrth i hynt y rhyfel newid yn y papurau newydd, mae'n neges ninnau yn dal yr un fath boed yn gyfnod o erchylltra neu 'heddwch' dros-dro*: heb wir gyfiawnder ni fydd gwir heddwch. Rhaid mynd i'r afael ag achosion sylfaenol brawychiaeth. Mae traus yn esgor ar drais. Mae rhyfel a pharatoi ar gyfer rhyfel yn achosi niwed mawr iawn i'r amgylchedd, yn cynyddu'r ymdeimlad o anghyfiawnder ymhliith pobl dan ormes a heb bwer ym mhedwar ban y byd, ac yn creu amgylchedd ffrwythlon o ran denu pobl i fynd yn frawychwyr. 
