JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Monthly Bulletin - August 1990

August proved a fitting climax to the junior cricket season with several events providing a feast of cricket throughout the month, with all age groups being involved.

Following on from the success of last months U/11 6-a-side tournament organised by Newport Cricket Club, August saw U/13 and U/15 6-a-side competitions with teams from all over South East Wales being invited to attend. Both events proved to be very popular and the performances of the Newport teams were outstanding with the U/15's winning their competition, and the U/13's losing in the semi-finals to eventual winners Pontypridd. Due to the overwhelming success of these Junior competitions it has already been decided to make each of the tournaments an annual event.

The highlight of the season however was undoubtedly the Juniors Double Wicket Competition held on Bank Holiday Sunday. A notable first for the youth section has been the formation of an U/9 section coached by current 1st team players Dave Knight and Graham Kingston. As a result of the youngsters enthusiasm and alround improvement during the season it was decided to hold an U/9's Double Wicket Competition along with the other age groups. The whole day was devoted to U/9, U/11, U/13 and U/15 competitions and a large crowd of parents and club members watched enthralled at the level of skill shown by the youngsters. It was clearly evident that lots of people left the ground in no doubt that many of these youngsters would distinguish themselves in cricket circles in the future.

The Double Wicket Competitions brought down the curtain for Juniors cricket on the historic Rodney Parade ground, and we can now look forward to the development of a brand new ground, where in the not too distant future the current junior players of the Club will be able to display their acquired skills and launch an exciting new era for Newport Cricket Club.
