Story

While international travel was on a go-slow during the Covid19 restrictions, attention turned to local tourism opportunities, particularly to places of natural beauty such as the North Pembrokeshire coastline.

After some pandemic-related delays, summer 2021 saw the first Fishguard Bay Boat Tours set sail from [Fishguard Dock](#), under the expert guidance of Skippers Padrig and Ffion Rees of Blue Shark Charters and Falcon Boats. From a family of local seafarers, the Rees' knowledge of the coastal waters epitomizes the values and mission of our company, [North Pembrokeshire Tours](#) (NPT): to deliver homegrown, authentic tours of under-recognised sites in the region by land, via Fishguard Walking Tours, and by sea, on the recently-launched Fishguard Bay Boat Tours.

Telling the lesser-known [stories of Fishguard and Goodwick](#) against the stunning backdrop of the rugged Welsh coastline, Fishguard Bay Boat Tours offer an up-close view of the exceptional maritime heritage, wildlife and scenery that define this ancient region. Whether you're interested in lighthouses or porpoises, the [Last Invasion](#) or the [First Flight across the Irish Sea](#), [Pirate Black Barti](#)'s booty or Strumble Head, the view of the north Pembrokeshire coast from the sea is unparalleled, with many hidden surprises! Boat tours last approximately 1.5 hours, departing from Fishguard harbour and reaching Strumble Head.

Local knowledge combining a passion for the fascinating history and landscape of the wild north led to the establishment of North Pembrokeshire Tours in 2018. With funding support from LEADER and Fishguard and Goodwick Chamber of Trade and Tourism, NPT was established with local tour leaders and continues to operate on a not-for-profit basis to deliver high-quality tour experiences that bring tourists face-to-face with the wide variety of sites of interest across North Pembrokeshire. Our mission is to deliver affordable small tours to visitors and residents, showcasing the array of historical, cultural, natural and architectural features that make North Pembrokeshire so unique. In doing so, we support local talent by sourcing marketing, printing and branding within the region, and generate further activity across the region by stimulating social media interest and footfall in local businesses.

Our hope is that the success of Fishguard Bay Boat Tours will allow us to expand our network of local guides and experts to deliver tours in other areas around the North Pembrokeshire area – there's so much to be discovered here, by residents and visitors alike.

Wrth i deithio rhyngwladol arafu'n sylweddol yn ystod cyfyngiadau Covid19, rhoddwyd sylw i gyfleoedd twristiaeth lleol, ac i ardaloedd o harddwch naturiol megis arfordir Gogledd Sir Benfro yn arbennig.

Ar ôl ychydig oedi oherwydd y pandemig, gwelwyd Teithiau Cwch cyntaf Bae Abergwaun yn hwylio o [Ddoc Abergwaun](#) yn ystod yr haf 2021, dan arweiniad arbenigol Sgiperiaid Padrig a Ffion Rees o Blue Shark Charters a Falcon Boats. Maent yn dod o deulu lleol o forwyr ac mae gwybodaeth teulu Rees o'r dyfroedd ar hyd yr arfordir yn crisialu gwerthoedd a chenhadaeth ein cwmni, [Teithiau Gogledd Sir Benfro](#) (NPT): sef cynnig teithiau cartref a dilys o safleoedd nad ydynt yn cael eu cydnabod ddigon yn y rhanbarth ar y tir, trwy Deithiau Cerdded Abergwaun, ac ar y môr, ar wasanaeth Teithiau Cwch Bae Abergwaun a lanswyd yn ddiweddar.

Gan adrodd straeon llai adnabyddus [Abergwaun ac Wdig](#) wrth fwynhau'r golygfeydd godidog o arfordir gerwin Cymru, mae Teithiau Cwch Bae Abergwaun yn cynnig golwg agos o'r dreftadaeth fôr eithriadol, y bywyd gwyllt a'r golygfeydd sy'n diffinio'r rhanbarth hynafol hwn. Os oes gennych chi ddiddordeb mewn goleudai neu lamhidyddion, yr [Ymosodiad Diwethaf](#) neu'r [Daith Gyntaf mewn Awyren ar draws Môr Iwerddon](#), trysor [Barti Ddu neu Ben-caer](#), mae'r olygfa o arfordir gogledd Sir Benfro yn un heb ei hail, a bydd sawl syrpreis annisgwyl! Bydd y teithiau cwch yn para tua 1.5 awr, gan adael o harbwr Abergwaun a hwylio allan i Ben-caer.

Arweiniodd cyfuniad o wybodaeth leol ac angerdd ynghylch hanes a thirlun rhyfeddol yr arfordir gwyllt yng ngogledd y sir at sefydlu Teithiau Gogledd Sir Benfro yn 2018. Gyda chymorth ariannol gan LEADER a Siambr Fasnach a Thwristiaeth Abergwaun ac Wdig, sefydlwyd NPT gydag arweinwyr teithiau lleol, ac mae'n parhau i weithredu ar sail nid-er-elw er mwyn cynnig profiadau o ansawdd uchel ar ffurf teithiau sy'n dwyn twristiaid wyneb yn wyneb gydag amrywiaeth eang y safleoedd o ddiddordeb ar draws Gogledd Sir Benfro.

Ein cenhadaeth yw cynnig teithiau bach fforddiadwy i ymwelwyr a phreswylwyr, gan arddangos cyfoeth y nodweddion hanesyddol, diwylliannol, naturiol a phensaernïol sy'n gwneud Gogledd Sir Benfro mor unigryw. Wrth wneud hyn, rydym yn cynorthwyo talent lleol trwy sicrhau cyflenwyr marchnata, argraffu a brandio yn y rhanbarth, gan ysgogi gweithgarwch pellach ar draws y rhanbarth trwy gymell diddordeb ar gyfryngau cymdeithasol a chynyddu nifer yr ymwelwyr â busnesau lleol.
