The will of George Thomas of Cowbridge, Attorney at Law, dated 2nd., August 1710.

To his brother, Thomas Lewis of Llanblethian, £20.

To his nephew, Edward Powell of Cowbridge, £10 and a writing desk, a clock and scrator?

To his niece, Wenllian Powell also David of Penlline, widow, £10.

To Mary and Barbra, daughters of Wenllian Powell, £10 each.

To his niece, Mary Thomas, who lived with him, in consideration of her good service, £20 and all the household goods excepting those mentioned above.

To Mary, daughter of Edward Powell, £10.

To Edward Powell all the books relating to the law.

To Edward, the son of his nephew Thomas Lewis, £10 to place him in an apprenticeship and to be managed by Edward's grandfather, Thomas Lewis of Llanblethian.

To Edward, son of Thomas Lewis, the house and appurtenances in Laleston, mortgaged to him by Thomas Lewis.

The chattel lease of the house in Cowbridge where he lived which had recently been made over to him by ^{Henry} ~~Mary Thomas~~ Richard, to Edward son of Thomas Lewis.

£12 to be set aside to defray funeral expenses.

Thomas Lewis, Edward Powell and Wenllian Powell to be joint executors.

The mark of George Thomas. (Illness?)

Proved 25th., May 1711.

In the Name of God Amen. I George Thomas attorney
at Law, of the town of Cowbridge in the County of Glamorgan, being
sick and weak in body, yet of a disposing mind and perfect memory,
revoking, annulling, and making void, all former wills and testaments, so
by me made, do make this my last will and testament in manner and
form following.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Brother Thomas Lewis
of Llanblethian the sum of twenty pounds — — —

Item I give and bequeath to my nephew Edward Powch of
Cowbridge the sum of ten pounds, with my writing Desk, Black Board
Scribster — — —

Item I give and bequeath to my dear Welshman powch at David of
Penygroes widow, the sum of ten pounds — — —

Item I give and bequeath to Mary and Barbara Daughters of the aforesaid
Welshman Powch at David, the sum of ten pounds each — — —

Item I give and bequeath to my niece Mary thomas, that now lives with
me, in consideration of her affection to god services the sum of twenty
pounds with all my household goods, excepting the Clock, writing Table
Sometime, which I have bequeathed to my nephew Edward Powch — — —

Item I give and bequeath to Mary daughter of the aforesaid Edward
Powch the sum of ten pounds as a token of my affection — — —

Item I give & bequeath to the aforesaid Edward Powch all my books
relating to the Law — — —

Item I give and bequeath to Edward, Son of my nephew Thomas Lewis the sum
of ten pounds to putt him an apprentice the management of wch I do hereby
refer to his grandfather, the aforesaid Thomas Lewis of Llanblethian — — —

Item I give and bequeath to the said Edward, Son of my nephew Thomas
Lewis, the house and appertanency thereto belonging, at Laleston, mortgaged
to me by his father the said Thomas Lewis — — —

Item as for the Chattels ~~left~~ ^{left} fully made over unto me, by Harry Richards
of the said town of Cowbridge ^{of the said town} wherein I now live, I give and bequeath the residue
and torms of years as yet unexpired therein, during the lives therein mentioned, unto the
aforesaid Mary Thomas, and after her deceas, to the aforesaid Edward the son of
my nephew Thomas Lewis — — —

Item I set apart and appoyal the sum of twelve pounds, in order to defray
my funeral expences — — —

I do hereby freely nominate & appoint the aforesaid Thomas Lewis, of
Larkethian, Edward Towne of Cowbridge, & Welshian Towne at Dowl
to be my just Executors of this my last will & testament. in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day day of
August, in the year of our Lord 1710.
