 do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all & singular
 y^e Land of goods Chatts & Credits of y^e s^d Deceased w^{ch} have or shall come
 hereafter to y^e hands, possession, or knowledge of them the s^d Mary
 & Anne Deere or into y^e hands, & possession of any person or persons for them
 or of some so made, do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into y^e registry
 of y^e Consistory Court of Landave = at or before y^e fourth
 Day of October next ensuing; & y^e same good, true & perfect
 & all other y^e goods, Chatts & Credits of y^e s^d Deceased, at y^e time of his
 death, which at any time after, shall come to y^e hands or possession
 of y^e s^d Mary & Anne Deere or into y^e hands, & possession of any other
 person or persons for them do well & truly administer according to law, &
 further do make, or cause to be made a true & just account of
 y^e administration at or before y^e fourth Day of October
 1721 = of all y^e rest & residue of y^e s^d Goods, Chatts, & Credits, w^{ch}
 shall be found upon y^e s^d administrators account, of same being first
 examined & allowed of by y^e Judge or Judges for y^e time being of y^e Court
 shall deliver, pay unto such person or persons respectively, as y^e Judge or
 Judges, by his or their decree or sentence, pursuant to y^e true intent & me-
 aning of an act of Parliamt, made in y^e two & twentieth, thirtieth
 & fourth years of y^e Reign of our late Sovereign Lord King Charles
 Charles the second. Intituled (an act for y^e better selling of intailed
 estates) shall limit & appoint, & if it shall hereafter appear, that any
 last will & testam^t was made by y^e s^d Deceased, & y^e executor or executors
 therein named do exhibit y^e same into y^e s^d Court, making request to
 have it allowed & approved accordingly if y^e s^d Mary & Anne Deere
 above bounden, being thereunto required, do tender & deliver
 y^e Letters of administration, (approbation, of y^e s^d testam^t being first
 had & made) in y^e s^d Court, then this obligation to be void & of none effect
 or else to remain in full force & virtue
