 doe make and ordaine this my last will and Testament in
 manner and forme following. First and principally
 I commend my soule unto the hands of Gods my maker
 and redeemer, and my body to be buried in Christian
 buriall. Item I give and bequeath towards the Cathedral
 Church of Landaff 10^s and towards my parish Church
 10^s. Item I give and bequeath to my ~~son~~ grandchild
 David Lewis and eldest Lewis, to each of them 20^s. Item
 I give and bequeath to my three grandchildron Pees Ear
 Margarett Exon and Batherin Exon 10^s to each of them
 10^s. Item I give and bequeath to my grandchild
 Margarett Milt, 20^s. Item I give and bequeath to
 my Grandchild Barbara Exon 20^s. Item I give
 and bequeath to my son Milt David 20^s, upon
 condition he live peaceably and quietly not molesting
 or troubling his brother. Item I give and bequeath
 to my Niece Tamson Thomas 20^s. Item I give
 I doe hereby give and bequeath to my son William
 David all the houses and lands I possess with all the
 appurtenances thereto belonging and all the rest of
 my goods cattels and Chattels, he fulfilling my will
 before specified and discharging my debts and I doe
 nominate and appoint my said son William David
 Executor of this my last will and
 Testament, for witness whereof I have hereunto
 put my hand the day and yeere above written.
