 perfect memory have and praise be to Almighty God,  
 doe make and ordaine this my last will and Testament in  
 manner and forme following. First and principally  
 I commend my soule unto the hands of Gods my maker  
 and redeemer, and my body to be buried in Christian  
 buriall. Item I give and bequeath towards the Cathedral  
 Church of Landawh y<sup>e</sup> and towards my parish Church  
 y<sup>e</sup>. Item I give and bequeath to my ~~son~~ grandchildron  
 David Lewis and Alst Lewis, to each of them y<sup>e</sup>. Item  
 I give and bequeath to my three grandchildron Peed Evan  
 Margaroth Evan and Batherin Evan y<sup>e</sup> to every of them  
 y<sup>e</sup>. Item I give and bequeath to my grandchild  
 Margaroth Milt, y<sup>e</sup>. Item I give and bequeath to  
 my Grandchild Barbara Evan y<sup>e</sup>. Item I give  
 and bequeath to my sonne Milt David y<sup>e</sup>, upon  
 condition he live peaceably and quietly not molesting  
 or troubling his brother. Item I give and bequeath  
 to my Niece Tamson Thomas y<sup>e</sup>. Item I give  
 I doe hereby give and bequeath to my sonne William  
 David all the houses and lands I possess w<sup>th</sup> all the  
 appurtenances thereto belonging and all the rest of  
 my goods cattels and Chattels, he fulfilling my will  
 before specified and discharging my debts and I doe  
 nominate and appoint my said sonne William David  
 Executor of this my last will and  
 Testament, for witness whereof I have hereunto  
 put my hand the day and yeere above written.
