In the name of god dater: I John Edward of the parise
of Llanllihau in the County of Beaumaris wianer being
liche in bodie but yet of fift mervit by yonth be it vnde
god, do make my last will and testamant in manner and
forme following: first and forme of remende my fader
into the handes of Almighte god my maker to bee disposed
of, and my body to bee buried in a Christian buriall—
I do give and bequeath unto Anne Robert ^{my wife} three and
tyre quarters of lande more or lesse during her life
time and after her dease unto my son, and on
her to pay with me by yare of one whole yare to gib
her Chare the summe of fift pounds after the encyment
of the said lande, and for want of payment of doe bequeath
the tyre quarters unto her and her heires for tyme, item
of fyve and bequeath unto me said wife to see her; and
to my daughter two ^{daughters} bequeath unto my said wife
one acre of meadow, the bequeath unto me said wife
mit Durant y eare during her widew estate, and all
my chattle suffe to bee imparted belawne my wif: and
me forfaid daughter, itt of bequeath the benefite
of one chattle lease for the yare ^{comlyc} towards their
maintenanc, and after the determinacion of yere
yare ended unto my son David wifson of doe nominac
constitute and appoint exector of his my last
will and testamant.—
