

Memorandum that on or aboute the 14th day of October
in the yeare of our Lord God one thousand six hundred
eighty & seven Margrett Foster of Southham in the
County of Glamorgan and diocess of Landoff. & in the
maier and portland this her last will and testament
in maner and form followinge, I doe
testifye Comended her soule unto god Almightye
and Jesus Christe her redemmer sufferinge by
his precious deathe and passion of Jesus Christe
her Saviour to be saved, and her bodye to be
buried in Christiane buriale. I doe give and
bequeath to Thomas Jonkin, the sonne of John
Foster her Nephew twenty shillings of lawfull
Englishe monny. I doe give to John Jonkin
the sonne of the said John Foster five shillings of
like lawfull monny, I doe give unto Jane
Jonkin her Niece an onlie garter, all the rest
of her good Chattels and Conables movables and
personables both within doore and without doore
I doe give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Morgan
the daughter of Morgan Daw of Southham
aforesaid, in the gift and givinge of Evan
Jonkin, and Evan Edward, and not long after
departed this life
