I give and bequeath my soul to the hands of the almighty maker of heaven and earth and my body to be buried in a Christian buriall

- # I bequeath to the Cathedrall church of Landoff 18 0
- # I bequeath towards the poor of the sd parish 12 0
- # I bequeath to my brother James Jenkin 12 10
- # I bequeath to my sisters daughters 12 10
- # I bequeath to my daughter Jane Thomas the sum of 40 0
- # I bequeath to my brother in law Lowelin Morgan . 00 40
- # and shd sd 40 to be paid to Honor Richard or her assignes
- # I beque towards my buriall 05 8
- # I give and bequeath all the goods and Chattels not it named for and nominated unto my well beloved wife Anne Christopher home of Constatide and appointed to be my whole and sole executrix of this my last will and testament in the presence of us
