The admin, dated 12th December 1760 names Thomas Howell of Llanblethian, yeoman; Humphrey Mathew of Llanblethian, butcher and Evan Mathew of Llanblethian, butcher. It also describes Edward David as being a widower and Catherine Howell , the executrix, as being his daughter and wife of Thomas Howell. The bond is set at £300.



I know all Men by this presents that we Thomas Howell of the parish of Lambeth in the County of Glamorgan Yeoman, Humphrey Mathew of the same parish Butcher, and Evan Mathew of the same parish Butcher

we have bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God Willielm by divine permission Lord Bishop of Land in the sum of three Hundred pounds of good and lawful Money of Great Britain to be paid unto the said Lord Bishop or his lawful Attorney his Exors. Administrators or Assignes for the good and faithful payment of the same well and truly to be well and truly bind ourselves each of us bind ourselves severally for the whole and firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated the 12th Day of December in the 17th Year of our Lord Christ, 1760.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if Catherine Howell of the County of Glamorgan Thomas Howell of the natural and lawful Daughter and Administratrix of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Edward David late of the parish of Lambeth in the County of Glamorgan and Diocess of Landaff widower deceased

do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the said Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Catherine Howell

or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for her and the same do exhibit the same to be exhibited into the Registry of the Consistory Court of Landaff at or before the twelfth Day of March next ensuing and the same Goods Chattels and Credits and the said Inventory and Receipts of the said deceased which at the time of her Death or which at anytime after shall come to the hands and possession of the said Catherine Howell

or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for her do well and truly administrate and to the said Court further do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Receipt of her said Administration at or before the twelfth Day of December which will come the Year 1761

and all the rest and residue of the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administration Receipt the same being first examined and allowed of by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively and said Judge by his Decree or Sentence pursuant to the true Intent Meaning and Effect of an Act of Parliament intituled an Act for the better settling of Testators Estates shall limit and appoint and if brought in shall appear that any last will and Testament was made by the said deceased and the said or the therein named do exhibit the same into the said Court making request to have the same accordingly if the said Catherine Howell

being first had and made into the said Court then this Bond shall be void and null and otherwise remain in full force and Virtue. Thomas Howell
