

The will of Richard Rees, Mason of Llanblethian, dated 19th February 1842.

To his grandson, Richard Rees, his watch.

To his son, Richard Rees, the sum of one shilling. *and his clothes*

To his beloved wife Jane Rees, who was to be the sole executrix of the will, all lands, personal property and goods held on his death. He further ordains that she shall sell or order to sell such partition of the lands and houses left her to pay all debts.

Witnesses: William John, William Price, and the mark of Thomas Jenkins.

2^o I give and Bequeath to my son Richard Pies
after my Decease the sum one Shilling and my Clothe.

3^o I give and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Jane
Pies whom I likewise constitute make and Ordain
the sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament,
and all singular My Lands, Messuages and Tenements,
and all personal property that I shall die possessed of,
I further Ordain that she shall sell or Order to sell in
Lots, such portion of the Lands and Houses which will
be left her at my Decease to pay all Debts which I may
be indebted at my Death and that she shall pay or
Cause to pay the same and the Remainder by her freely
to be possessed and enjoyed for Ever.

And I do hereby utterly disallow, Revoke, and Disannul
all and every former Will, by me in any way before
made, Willed and Bequeathed, I do hereby Ordain and
Confirm this and no other to be my last will and Testament,
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal, this 19th day of February the Year of Our Lord
One Thousand Eight Hundred and forty two
