In the name of god Amen the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November 1673  
I Lewis Mathew of the parish of Colchester within the County  
of Landgrave beinge sick in bodye but yett perfect in my  
mind and senses do herebye shew unto all my friends god for maker  
& ordain my last will and testament in manner and  
form followinge, first I Comitt my soule to god &  
my bodye to be buried in christen buriall, Item I  
give and bequeath towards the Churchwarden of  
Landgrave parish, Item I give and bequeath towards  
my wife Anne Mathew, Item I give and bequeath  
the second of my wife's parish, Item I give & bequeath  
unto my sonne Matthew Lewis on standing bedstead  
on Cheboard and on table beere lyinge & beinge  
in the hall, Item I give and bequeath to my  
sonne Thomas Lewis two closets, one Closet  
and a meadow herunto adjoininge called by the  
name of the Redd Cleeve and graine beinge  
by Estimation ten acres or thereabouts, the other  
closet called by the name of the Redd Cleeve by Estimation  
six acres four and drudging the steere of ten  
years, on furring bedstead, on dustbed two blackette  
on weight twigg, on bolster, and on Quire, Item I  
give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Lewis the  
youngest best, w<sup>ch</sup> shee keeps or erres, 3<sup>th</sup> of money  
now in the hand of ~~Marye Lewis~~ of Colchester  
the parish of Colchester, 3<sup>rd</sup> in the hand of  
Margarett Garret Widow, two milch kine & two  
acres of <sup>nowe in the ground</sup> ~~meadow~~ with all and singular implements  
of husbandrye thereto not named afore & bequeathed  
and one Closet & one meadow called by the name  
of the Redd Cleeve and graine y<sup>e</sup> bout by Estimation  
& accord or thereabouts after the death of my  
wedded wife Elizabeth Lewis and not afore

for and Inninge hee learned and Cared of two years hereafter  
 hee next following, And at the expiration of the term  
 of years hereafter upon the aforesaid ten shilled land  
 hee hee said Thomas Lewis my will is that my sonne  
 Matthew Lewis shall have and enjoy the same Inninge  
 hee hee said of his naturall life, And finally I  
 doe hereby ordaine devise and appoint my wife Elizabeth  
 wife Elizabeth Lewis to be my sole and right  
 executrix of this my last will and testament  
 in manner and forme aforesaid, to see my legacies  
 paid, and funerall expences discharged, for witness  
 whereof I have caused to put my hand and seal  
 the day and years above written
