In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Jenkin of Llynwney in the county of Glamorgan hitho:  
being sick in body, but of sound and perfect memory, praye be to Almighty God do make and or=  
daine this my last will and testament (renouncing all former wills what so ever by word or writing  
what so ever) in manner and form following (that is to say) I do give and principally I commend  
my soul into the hand of Almighty God Hoping through the merits Death and Passion of my  
Saviour Jesus christ to have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit  
Everlasting life: and my body I commit to the earth to be decently buried: And touching the  
disposition of all such temporal estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow on me I give  
and bestow as followeth. First I will that all my debts and Funeral charges shall be paid  
and discharged. Item all my personal estate goods and chattels I give my son Jenkin  
Robert and nominate and appoint him my full and sole executor of this my last will and  
testament. he being under age I nominate and appoint my wife Margaret and my Sister  
Jane Howard vid: to be overseers of this my last will and ~~the~~ testament and of my son Jenkin  
Robert till he comes to be of full age witness whereunto I set my hand and seale on the  
20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1700.

 made a true and just account of her = s<sup>u</sup>ch taken all or before y<sup>e</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> day of August  
 Anno D<sup>omi</sup>n<sup>i</sup> 1702 = And all y<sup>e</sup> rest and Residue of y<sup>e</sup> said goods, Chats & Credits w<sup>h</sup>ich shall be  
 found remaining upon y<sup>e</sup> said p<sup>ro</sup>curator her account by same being first examined & allowed by y<sup>e</sup>  
 Judge or Judges for y<sup>e</sup> time being of y<sup>e</sup> said Co<sup>ur</sup>t shall be paid & pay unto such p<sup>ro</sup>curator or p<sup>ro</sup>curators respectively as  
 y<sup>e</sup> said Judge or Judges by his or their Decree or Sentence pursuant to y<sup>e</sup> true intent & meaning of y<sup>e</sup>  
 Statute of Parliam<sup>en</sup>t in that behalf made & Ord<sup>er</sup>s shall limit<sup>ed</sup> & appoint. And if it shall
