I do give unto my daughter Anne & Thomas thirty pounds to be payd unto her yo wife in yo turnyasse off four years after yo date her of

I do give unto my son William & Thomas twenty pounds to be payd unto him or to his yo wife in the turnyasse off three years after the date here off

I do give unto my son John & Thomas twenty pounds to be payd unto him or his yo wife in yo turnyasse off five years after off

I do nominate and appointe my son Watkin Thomas to be my executor off this my last will and testament

It is my desire yt George Nichol shall be guardian off this my executor and Watkin maner to be the other guardian of this my executor and of this my last will and testament & for if this my will shall be sufficient
