Bequests

All my freehold land in Glamorgan to my rightful heir

Thomas Robert, who is my executor.

to my nephew, Edward Thomas, twenty pounds

to my nephew Robert Thomas, fifteen pounds

to Catherine, daughter of Thomas Robert, my executor, fifteen pounds.

These bequests to be paid to Edward, Robert and Catherine when they come of age.

to Cissil Thomas , my sister, fifteen pounds

all the rest of my goods ,chattels etc to my executor Ronert Thomas on condition

he pays my debts and legacies.

In the name of God Amen ^{1681/68} 28 of January m^o
Year 168 after the computation of the Church of England
Morgan Thomas of Porthlinc in the County of Glamorgan
for being sick in body but in good memory and remembrance
do make and ordains this my last will and testament in man-
ner and form following

first I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of the al-
mighty god hoping that through the meritorious death and passion
of our Saviour Jesus Christ to receive free pardon for all my
sins as for my body to be buried in Christian buriall at the di-
cretion of my executor hereafter nominated

I do give and bequeath all my free hold that ever I have in
Glamorgan shire unto Thomas Robert my executor which is
my right heir I do give and bequeath unto Edward Thomas
my nephew Twenty poundes I do give and bequeath unto
Robert Thomas my nephew fifteen poundes I do give and
bequeath unto Catering Thomas daughter of Thomas the best my
bestor fifteen poundes to be payd unto the said Edward and Tho-
mas and Catering when they come in age I do give and bequeath
unto Giffel Thomas my sister fifteen poundes I do give
the said Thomas Robert my sole executor of all my landes & ten-
mentes shopes moveables and immoveables and all that I have or
shall have of the said parts upon condition that he shall
shall pay all my debts and legacies and perform this my last
will and testament at the doing all other wills and testaments
