Will dated 6th August 1671

to Cissill Deare my niece ,ten pounds

to my brother and his wife twenty two shillings apiece in gold

to Morice Williams and his wife twenty ^{two} shillings each in gold

to, David Lewis and his wife twenty two shillings each in gold

to my niece Ann Lewis ten pounds

to Anthony Powell my nephew ,one pound

to the two sons of Griffith Gibbon ,one pound each

to Joan Deare one pound

WILL OF JOANE DEER alias JENKINS, of Welsh St. Donats 1674, LL/1674/101/W

[Llanquian branch]

Joane left quite a vast legacy, much of it in gold. She and her late husband were farmers by the contents of the will. She also had sums of money out at mortgage, and money at interest by bond on several persons. The legacies are given in Roman numerals which I have tried to duplicate as best I can, but probably inaccurately. This will should help sort out quite a few individuals. There is some damage on the RHS of the sheet, but nothing that can't be guessed at.
