- 1848 Marriage of James Braddick, labourer of Llanblethian, son of James Braddick,
labourer to Mary Richards of Llanblethian, daughter of David Richards, farmer

- 1851 Thomas and Maria Prichard, gardener, 53 born Manordeifi, Cardigan *Census 70*
- 1857 Marriage of James Braddick, widower, coachman of Llanblethian, son of James
Braddick, farmer, to Elizabeth James, dressmaker of Llanblethian

- 1852 Thomas Prichard occupied; Mrs Thomas owned – house by mill

- 1861 Thomas Prichard, with wife and son David, aged 38, gardener *Census 78*
- 1867 Marriage of Amos Govier Henry Braddick (domestic servant at Marlborough
Grange), son of James Braddick, farmer to another servant at the Grange

- 1868 Conveyance, Robert C... Thomas to James Braddick
- 1871 James Braddick, 47, gardener, with wife and son *Census 76*
- 1874 James Braddick owned and occupied – house and garden by the mill (and 5 acres
in Llanfrynach) *Glam. County Rate 71*
- 1881 James and Eliza Braddick *Census 77*
- 1891 James Braddick *Kelly's directory*
- 1891 Conveyance, James and Eliza Braddick to Eliza Braddick.
- 1895 Mr Braddick *Kelly's*
- 1906 Mrs Braddick *Kelly's*

- 1909 Eliza Braddick died 19/12/1909. Miles was a trustee, who then conveyed the garden opposite to Williams. *Deeds of St Quentins Cottage.*
'All that piece or parcel of garden ground being one of the gardens belonging to Testatrix's freehold house....35 perches.'
Conveyance, trustee of estate to Thomas Butler of Prisk, late collier
Deeds of St Quentins Cottage
- 1910 Indenture between E W Miles (1), Thomas Butler (2) and George Williams of Llanblethian, wheelwright (3)
- 1912 Mrs Nicholl occupied; J Butler owned – house and garden near mill £12-15

- 1914 Misses Llewellyn

- 1926 Revd James McLauchlan (Wesleyan minister)

- 1930s Viv Wythe's parents bought the property. Before them was Mrs Butler. Mrs Morgan (her husband worked at Park Hospital, Bridgend) followed on from Viv's parents.
- 1946 Derrick H Jefferson, minister of religion (Wesleyan)

- 1960s-70s Perriman family
