ROYDS

John **Royds** = Ann Gilbert
of Falinge, Rochdale
1729 -99
(They had 10 children altogether)

James **Royds** of Falinge = Mary Smith
(they had 12 children altogether)

Mary Anne Royds = Lt Hugh **Entwisle** in Rochdale in 1824. They settled in Llanblethian (Llanblethian Cottage, then Marlborough Grange). Had no children. She died 1878; buried in Llanblethian

Frances Royds = John Gilbert **Royds**, her cousin in 1843. She was his second wife. After his death in 1869 she lived with her sister Mary Anne in Marlborough Grange

Thomas **Royds** of Greenhill, Rochdale = Elizabeth Smith (Mary's sister)
died Cheltenham 1819
(They had 9 children)

John Gilbert **Royds** = Ellen Entwisle in Rochdale in 1804. Ellen died 1827; he married Frances Royds in 1843. Lived for a while at Clemenstone. Was living in Cheltenham when he died in 1849

Capt William **Royds** = Georgiana Peel of Aylesmore House, Glos. Owned several Llanblethian houses, eg St Quintins, The Cross, and in 1820 was tenant of Clemenstone. He died at Cheltenham in 1858

Ellen Royds = Revd Geo **Traherne** of St Hilary in 1824

Frederick Charles Alton **Royds**, b Clemenstone 1827. Married Frances Paul Royds in Tetbury in 1857. They lived in St Quintins. He died 1863 in a riding accident nr Tetbury; had ben a county magistrate

Adelaide Royds = John **Oldham** 1859 (son of James Oldham, Esq)

Alicia Vittoria Royds = William **Oldham** (son of James Oldham, Esq). Alicia was living at Kingscombe Farm when married at Llanblethian Church in 1863

Frances **Traherne**, b St Hilary 1830; lived with her mother at The Cross 1871; died 1872

3 other children, one of whom became the grandfather of the late Sir Cenydd **Traherne**
