

## Index of Llantrithyd people – J B Loudon

**Abraham** David, born ca 1748 of Town of Cowbridge, married Llantrithyd 24.12.1769  
Elizabeth Llewellyn, spinster of Llantrithyd

**Christopher** Mary, born Llantrithyd ca 1747, m William Rees of Llanblethian at  
Llantrithyd 11.5.1739

**John** John, 66, widower, grocer and farmer of 40 acres, employing one labourer,  
born Llanblethian - Lower Greenway  
(1871 census). Also at Lower Greenway (Pantmeyrick) in 1881

**Kitt** James, 64, born Pinhoe, Devon + wife Ann, 67 in Llantrithyd in 1891 (see  
Belgrave, Llanblethian)

**Morgan** Margaret, 1807 -1844, daughter of Christopher 1765 - 1859 by his first wife  
Ann Jones 1780-1811 of Ewenny. Baptised Llantrithyd 16.2.1807, married John John of  
Llanquian Uchaf (?). Only son was Thomas John, brewer of Aberthin, d 1885 - from whom is  
descended Arthur John of Cowbridge

**Morris** John, born ca 1778, probably husband of Margaret (1784-1857, buried  
Cowbridge). Probably father of Margaret, born ca 1817, baptised Llantrithyd 4.4.1817,  
daughter of John farmer and wife Margaret, buried Llantrithyd 1846, of Cowbridge  
Thomas, 1818 - 1845, possibly  
Jenkin, born ca 1820, baptised Llantrithyd 11.6.1821, son of John  
farmer and wife Margaret, buried Llantrithyd 1841, of Cowbridge  
Jane, born ca 1823, baptised Llantrithyd 6.9.1823, daughter of John &  
Margaret, buried Llantrithyd 19.9.1841, of Cowbridge  
Catherine, 1827-1857, buried Llantrithyd, of Cowbridge

**Smyth/Smith** William, born Westmeath, Ireland, ca 1790. Tithe, 1840: tenant of RT Tyler at  
the Rectory, called Parsonage House, and tenant of farm buildings to SE of the churchyard.  
Census 41, Parsonage House, HP 3rd Regt Foot, aged 50. 1850, elector by virtue of Glebe  
farm, abode at Parsonage; 1851, Parsonage farm, Lt HP 3rd Foot Guards. Married (2nd  
wife?) Anne, [buried Llantrithyd 1884, of Cowbridge]. Buried Llantrithyd 1882, aged 92,  
when said to be of Swansea, but possibly had a permanent home at Cowbridge.

**Thomas** Henry, born Llanblethian 1821, farmer, son of Thomas Thomas farmer, born Llanblethian 1784 and wife Anne, born Llanharry 1785.  
In Llantrithyd 1841-71 at Tydraw.  
Llewellyn, born Llanblethian 1814, in Tydraw in 1841-71. In 1881 had servant  
**Abraham Whitney**, 16, born Llanblethian  
William, probably born Llanblethian 1815-1820  
Evan, born Llanblethian 1827  
Thomas, as above, in Tydraw 1841

**Thomas** (1871 census)  
Edward, 45, coachman, born Welsh St Donats  
Mary, wife, 49, born Llanblethian  
Jane, daughter, 16, dressmaker, born Llanblethian

**Tutton** 1861 census:  
George E, 38, schoolmaster, born Cadoxton-juxta-Barry  
Caroline, wife, 40, born Llantrithyd  
Elizabeth, daughter, 13, born Llantrithyd  
Mary, daughter, 11, born Llantrithyd  
James, son, 10, born Llantrithyd  
Eva, daughter, 5, born Llantrithyd  
George, son, 2, born Llantrithyd  
Kate, daughter, 4, born Llantrithyd  
Elizabeth Evans, mother in law, 77, shoemaker's widow, born Llancarfan
