- 1824 Front of Broadway Farm : encroachment by Henry Edmunds, tenant *Bute terrier*
- 1841 Burial of Harry George *Llandough parish records*
- 1845/6 James Bird of Cowbridge - freehold house and garden on Broadway  
*Register of electors*
- 1849 James Bird of Cowbridge, freehold house and garden on Broadway  
*Reg. of electors*
- 1850 & 1855 James Bird, as above  
Evan Hopkin, farmhouse and land on Broadway *Reg. of electors*
- 1857 Will of James Bird, to his nephew William Bird - freehold dwelling house at  
Broadway, Llanblethian, now occupied by Martha Jones *Aberthin papers*
- 1857 Death of Mary, wife of Evan Hopkin of Broadway *Church records*
- 1859 James Giro of Broadway near Cowbridge - freehold tenement and land on  
Llanmihangel road  
House of Nathaniel Bird, Broadway, occupied by John Peggy and Ann Jones

- 1881 Nathaniel Bird, Broadway houses

- 1900 Broadway Farm - letting of 35 acres to Edward John for £60 *D/D SA 8/15*
- 1903 Theophilus Richards Hamlen Williams of Fairfield, Pontypridd and Shrublands,  
Kingsland, Herefordshire, died leaving all his property in trust for his wife and  
children (Broadway Farm etc., and including the Verlands)
- 1905 Death of William Jones of Broadway *Parish records*
- 1906 Death of Thomas Deere aged 75 *Parish records*
- 1909 Broadway cottage – Sale of Beaupre estate. Lot 11, freehold cottage and garden known  
as Broadway Cottage, now occupied by Mrs Daw at 14 shillings per month. Contains small  
shop, kitchen, dairy and pantry, parlour, 5 bedrooms, store room and WC. Good kitchen garden,  
cart shed and yard, and side entrance. *Sale documents*
- 1911 Farm and lands known as Broadway (28 acres) sold to Thurstan Bassett, £2400  
*SA 8/21*
- 1912 Revd Owen Jones (Baptist), Llanblethian Road  
Knowles and Taylor, plumbers *Kelly's*
- 1914 Death of Annie May Thomas, The Cottage, Broadway, aged 40 years  
*St Hilary parish records*
- 1914 Surrender - all those two closes of pasture called Broadway fields or Cecil  
Woodward's lands and a house called Broadway (tenant David Cox -  
Broadway  
Farm)
- 1926 Evan Warren, painter (near the school – Broadway Villas) *Kelly's*

- 1930 Death of George Thomas Cox of Broadway Farm aged 81 years  
*Llandough parish records*
- 1951 Conveyance of Broadway Farm to Glyn Morgan Thomas of Croesty Farm, Coity  
*Deeds*
- 1956 G M Thomas died, widow was Mrs Freda Thomas  
*Deeds*
- 1957 Death of Ellen Handasyde Nelson aged 71 years, Seaton, Broadway  
*Llandough parish records*
