BRIDGEND.

Bridgend is a market town in the Southern Division of Glamorgan, and has a station on the Great Western main line London to Fishguard, with branches to other centres. The Barry Co. also use the station for their railway from Barry to Bridgend. The distances from Bridgend are as follows:—London, 173 miles; Cardiff, 20; Llantrisant, 11; Cowbridge, 7. The town is a civil parish in the Bridgend and Cowbridge Union, and is under the control of the Urban District Council. Gas and water are supplied by a

company, but electricity, both for light and power, is supplied by the Council from their works.

There are numerous industries in the town and surrounding district, and facilities are given for the development of business premises, works and residential property. The rateable value is £48,355. The population in the area taken is about 9,000, and the names of those in the Urban District, as given in this book, are upwards of 2,000.

LLANTRISANT.

The parish of Llantrisant is a large one, but the town portion is not extensive, and is about 2 miles from the railway station of the Great Western on the main line London to Fishguard. The Taff Vale Co.'s station at Cross Inn is about 1 mile from the town centre.

Llantrisant forms part of the Cardiff Parliamentary constituency, and is under the control of the Llantrisant and Llantwit Vardre District Council. It

is distant 164 miles from London, 11. Bridgend; 11. Cardiff; 8, Cowbridge.

Pontyclun embraces a wide area, and is a growing district both for residential and industrial purposes. Here is the Llantrisant railway station of the Great Western Co., with connections on the Taff Vale Railway from Cowbridge to Pontypridd.

Tonyrefail, Gilfach Goch and other places given in this book are also rapidly increasing in population and becoming of commercial importance.

COWBRIDGE.

Cowbridge is a market town and agricultural centre, with a Council consisting of a mayor, 4 aldermen and 12 councillors. For parliamentary purposes it forms part of the constituency of Cardiff, and is in the Bridgend and Cowbridge Union. The railway is a branch of the Taff Vale Line. The distances are London, 187 miles; Bridgend, 7; Cardiff, 12; Llan-

trisant, 8. The lighting is by gas supplied by a company, the water supply is from springs and wells, and the drainage is under the control of the Corporation.

The Grammar School was founded in 1608, and there are numerous charities dating from 1682 for the relief of the poor. The district is mainly agricultural and residential.
