Krisztina de Châtel (Hungary)

De Châtel was born in Hungary but mainly worked in the Netherlands after studying modern dance in Essen, Germany. The Krisztina de Châtel Company was formed in Amsterdam in 1976 and was awarded the Sonia Gaskell Prize for outstanding choreography in 1987.

The piece *Trio* was created in 1987 and re-staged for *Diversions* in 1988. At the time, de Châtel was one of Europe's most innovative choreographers. Minimal dance patterns created an atmosphere of tension, expressing a highly-charged relationship between a woman and two men.
