

Broadway Hill, Llanblethian (from its junction with Castle Hill)

- 1851 David Lewis, gardener, 23, born Penmark, with wife Mary, born Marcross and two children aged 3 and 9 months, born Llanblethian *Census 49*
- 1881 David Hopkin, 79, annuitant, born Llanmihangel *Census 65*
- 1891 Robert Jones, 52, carpenter, born Llantrisant, and daughter Mary *Census 8*
- 1895 Ted 'Surrey' (Ted Morgan)

Em's Cottage (tiny cottage on the corner of Castle Hill)

- 1840 Owner John Perrott, occupier Thomas Jones *Llanblethian tithes*
- 1851 Occupied by Thomas Jones, pauper aged 81, former carpenter, born Llancarvan, with wife Ann, 71, b. Llangwnwyd *Census 52*
- 1881 Gwenny George, pauper, 77, born Llantrisant *Census 68*
- 1895 Thomas George, parish cottage
- 1910 Mrs Mary Morgan occupied, Llanblethian parish council owned – cottage & garden

Em Royle ('Aunt Em') – see photograph of cottage on fire ca 1990. It was derelict, then demolished and the site made into a little garden.

Born 8/2/1857 in Llanblethian, son of William Norton, tailor journeyman, and Ann nee Hopkins. *Birth certificate*

William Christopher Norton, 26, joiner of Cardiff, son of William Norton, tailor married Susannah Hopkins, 22, of Cowbridge on 19th May 1883

Marriage certificate

Susannah, b 17/12/1861, Colwinston, daughter of Edward Hopkins, agricultural labourer and Catherine, nee Gibbob *Birth certificate*

Will of Susannah Norton – executor & sole beneficiary was Evelyn Hopkins, her niece. Inventory attached *Will 9/3/1930*

William C Norton died 16/3/1943
