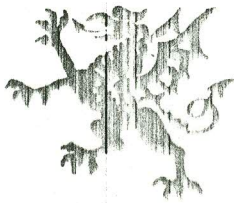


I think my memory has failed me since I can't recall sending you the letter I promised. If this is a duplication, excuse please.

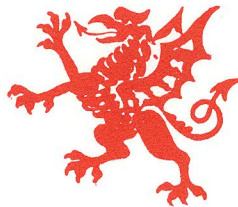

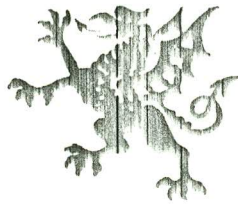
