Pwmp a Seremoni

Fire destroyed St Giles' Parish Church in 1463 and devastated the town centre in 1643. With fire a constant threat, insurance companies in the 18th century started to offer fire cover and set up fire brigades.

In 1852 the Provincial Insurance Company of Wrexham established the first fire brigade in North Wales. The clerks in the company's office on High Street served as firemen in emergencies and they kept the 'engine' in a shed on Chester Street.

Wrexham was a fast growing town in the mid-19th century and its leading citizens wanted to run their own affairs. In 1863 the townsfolk set up their own Volunteer Fire Brigade.

Dinistriodd tân Eglwys Blwyf San Silyn yn 1463 a difrododd ganol y dref yn 1643. Gyda thân yn fygythiad cyson, dechreuodd cwmnïau gynnig yswiriant yn y 18fed ganrif a sefydlu brigadau Tân.

Yn 1852 sefydlodd y Provincial Insurance Company, Wrecsam, y frigâd dân gyntaf yng Ngogledd Cymru. Y clercod yn swyddfa'r cwmni ar y Stryt Fawr oedd y diffoddwyr Tân mewn argyfngau ac roeddent yn cadw'r 'peiriant' mewn cwt ar Stryt Caer.

Roedd tref Wrecsam yn tyfu'n gyflym ynghanol y 19eg ganrif ac roedd ei dinasyddion blaenllaw eisiau rhedeg eu busnes eu hunain. Yn 1863 sefydlodd y trefolion eu Brigâd Dân Wifodol eu hunain.

The brigade encouraged donations by making anyone prepared to pay ten shillings a year an honorary member. Their annual ball was the society event of the year. The volunteers were an effective fire fighting force for nearly thirty years. However, over time expectations rose: the brigade was accused of being slow to respond to emergencies and not maintaining their equipment.

In 1895 the brigade resigned en masse after they were criticized in the council chamber. They were persuaded to return to duty and the town purchased a new fire engine, but eventually the volunteers fell out with the professional firemen employed by the council over their attendance at fires and drills.

The Borough Council established the Wrexham Fire Brigade, staffed by paid firemen, in 1904. It was the start of the modern fire service that we know today.

Roedd y frigâd yn annog rhoddion trwy wneud pawb oedd yn barod i dalu deg swilt y flwyddyn yn aelodau er anrhedd. Eu dawns flynyddol oedd achlysur ffasiynol y flwyddyn. Bu'r gwifodolwyr yn llu ymladd Tân effeithiol am ddeng mlynedd ar hugain bron. Fodd bynnag, cynyddodd disgwyliau gyda threigl amser: cyhuddwyd y frigâd o fod yn araf i ymateb i argyfngau ac nad oedd yn cynnal ei gyfarpar.

Yn 1895 ymddiswyddodd y frigâd i gyd ar ôl lladd arnynt yn y siambr y cyngor. Perswadiwyd rhw i ddychwelyd i'w dyletswydd a phrynod y dref injan Tân newydd. Fodd bynnag, aeth yn ddrwg maes o law rhwng y gwifodolwyr a'r diffoddwr tan proffesiynol a gyflogwyd gan y cyngor yngylch mynchy tanau a driliau.

Sefydlodd Cyngor y Fwrdeistref Frigâd Dân Wrecsam, gyda diffoddwyr Tân cyflogedig, yn 1904. Dyma ddechrau'r gwasanaeth Tân modern sy'n gyfarwydd inni heddiw.
