### **Review of minutes of December 7, 2002 meeting:**

Seminars: to be finalized at this meeting. They will be displayed in Welsh newspapers (Y Drych, Ninnau etc.).

Correction: The Eisteddfod Youth solo prize is \$75.

Rag Foundation will not be attending the Festival.

Ysgol Gerdd: Alan has been unsuccessful in contacting relevant person to confirm that the choir will be attending the Festival. He assumes they will be coming but must have a definite answer within the next two weeks. Mark Burrows has forwarded information on cheaper air fares with Air Transat to Ysgol Gerdd.

Alan will be instructing Ellis to print the registration forms after this meeting.

Alan has approached the British Council asking them to consider donating the 1,000 pounds to the folk group 'Mabon' if not interested in sponsoring Terry Breverton. A CV on Terry Breverton has been sent to them.

Alan has still had no response from Dunvant regarding an 'under 16' rugby team coming over. John Gough and Derwyn Philips have been contacted and are keen to organize an over 40's rugby match between local Welsh teams.

Haydn James has been asked to choose the hymns for the Gymanfa Ganu; 16 hymns for the afternoon session and possibly 12 hymns for the evening session. The list of hymns will be circulated to the Welsh newspapers for previewing.

There will be a disclaimer in the newspapers with regard to a change in program.

The new Richmond High School will probably not be completed by August 2003 but McNeil or McMath schools will be considered. We will need shuttle buses to transfer guests to either of these locations.

The CBC has agreed to be our main media sponsor and will start advertising the Festival around St. David's Day and again in July and August.

Alan and Don will met with CBC to check out feasibility of using their plaza for the Downtown Opening Ceremony.
