>> Hi: Here is a suggested guideline for persons who decide they want to
>> attend only 1 event. For discussion purposes, let's consider the Sunday
>> events as one event and consider each of the items on Thursday, Friday,
and
>> Saturday as separate events..

>> In the past the guideline we have found that works quite well is to not
>> charge a registration fee for persons who want to go to only one
event -- not
>> counting the Sunday schedule--but to charge them only the event charge.
>> Because they would be paying for only one event, they would not receive a
>> name tag, a program booklet, or shuttle service.
>>
>> However, if they register for a Thursday, Friday, or Saturday event IN
>> ADDITION to the sunday schedule, then they would have to pay the
>> registration fee and receive a nametag, program booklet, shuttle service,
>> and, of course, no charge for Sunday events.

>> Example 1. A person decides they want to only attend the banquet. Their

>> Example 5. A person wants to attend one Thursday, Friday, or Saturday
>> event PLUS the Sunday events. Must pay registration fee of $42.50 CAD,

>> US plus the cost of the events. Would receive name tag, program booklet,
>> shuttle service. NOTE: Added suggestion--How about modifying the
>> registration fee for on-site registrations back to the pre-August 1
>> figures. The rationale is that there are no added expenses for
>> Headquarters like there would be during the month of August.

>> By keeping it simple, it will be easier for the on-site registration
>> persons to understand what the charges are. It will also provide
