The committee includes a retired professor of vocal music, an Episcopal priest, and a Swansea Valley native who is a minister of music in a Baptist Church. They will give your choir every consideration. We would like to work out the choice of visiting choir by the time of the 1991 Welsh National or soon thereafter.

Mary Wise is on that committee. Mary and I have had encouragement from Marylou Wilkinson. I have played the tape sent by Marylou many times, including on long automobile trips (your 1983 and 1986 tapes), and I saw the choir appear on TV from Scranton on the Frugal Gormet show!
