Just a quick reiteration of the meeting last Friday, July 17th, 1987, with Mary Mergenthal, you, and me.

UPDATE FOR ST. PAUL '87

HOTELS (Review of presentation of last year)

Headquarters: Radisson St. Paul Hotel

\$60 flat rate up to quad

400 rooms

Additional hotels: Holiday Inn Town Square

\$53 flate rate up to quad

100+ rooms

St. Paul Hotel (a Lincoln Hotel)

\$70 flat rate up to quad

100 rooms with another 75 available if needed

All of these hotels are connected by means of St. Paul's skyway system.

GYMANFA SESSIONS

Director: Iwan Edwards of LaChiene, Quebec.

Organist: Gwyndaf Roberts of Utica, New York

The sessions will be held in the Roy Wilkins Auditorium, part of the St. Paul Civic Center complex. Seating capacity is from 2-5,000. Mr. Edwards will be in Minnesota this fall and we have arranged for him to see this facility.

SUNDAY WORSHIP SERVICE

Preaching minister: The Rev. Vivian Jones, native of Wales, and presently senior pastor of the Plymouth Congregational Church in Minneapolis. The service will be held at the Central Presbyterian Church in downtown St. Paul (The Rev. Neal Lloyd, once a member of the National Trustees Board of the Gymanfa Association) is a former pastor of this congregation).

CONCERT

Featured at the concert will be Ar Log, popular folk group and recording artists from Wales, and soprano soloist Janice Kimes of St. Paul. Mrs. Kimes has sung with the Rhos Choir in concert in Wales and is also the director of the Bel Canto Voices, a Twin Cities girls' choir which has competed at the National Eisteddfod in recent years.

For the concert, we are endeavoring to secure the Ordway Music Theater, which has seating for 1800 and is located just two blocks from the headquarters hotel. However, we must wait until their primary tenants, the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, the St. Paul Opera, and the Shubert Club, have set their programs for the year. In the event we are unable to use this facility, the concert will likely be held in the Radisson Hotel ballroom, which has seating capacity of 1,600 and will be very adequate.

We have been in contact with Mr. Jonathan Jones of the Welsh Tourist Board. They have indicated they will be happy to assist with the cost of bringing cultural groups here, much the same as they did in Montreal.
