At the September 28, 1996 meeting of the Milwaukee '97 Welsh National Gymanfa Ganu Committee a motion was made and passed to request a loan from the National Welsh Gymanfa GANu Association for the sum of \$7000.

As the Committee gets closer to the date of the '97 Gymanfa it finds that in spite of some very generous donations of time, talents and materials this large amount of money is needed at this time to go forward with the program.

The success of the Welsh World for Kids depends upon advertising this new event which takes printing and telephoning, postage, and hands-on materials to be of high interest to these young people. In like manner the Eisteddfod promotion and execution will have expenses now. Money is needed for both events.

We are at the point of signing contracts and find that down payments are required in some cases such as the banquet catering and the organ/piano rental. The amount in our treasury will not meet this expense. We, with good reason, expect to have a successful Gymanfa and do not expect to have a problem in paying back this loan.

Therefore, we formally request a loan of \$7000, interest free, to be paid back to the National Gymanfa Ganu Association at the completion of the National Gymanfa Ganu in Milwaukee in 1997.

Thank you for your consideration. We look forward with pleasure to meeting sometime this fall with you and The Rev. Dr. Cerwyn Davies.
