**PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING FOR  
1996 NATIONAL GYMANFA GANU**

A MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE WAS HELD SEPTEMBER 21, 1994 AT PLYMOUTH-BETHESDA CHURCH WITH 15 MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE.

STEVE REESE REPORTED ON THE NATIONAL GYMANFA GANU IN SEATTLE, WA. HE GAVE A RUN-DOWN ON EACH EVENT, INCLUDING THE NEWLY INSTITUTED EISTEDDFOD.

**REPORTS OF COMMITTEES:**

**BANQUET:** [OWEN & BETTY EVANS] THE DINNER WILL BE HELD AT HARTS HILL INN TO WHICH A DEPOSIT HAS BEEN MADE. THE TABLE FAVORS WILL BE CROCHETED TEA CUPS. WE WILL NEED A 1,000. AND SEVERAL MEMBERS HAVE SIGNED UP TO MAKE THEM.

**WORSHIP:** [MAIR LLOYD] A DISCUSSION WAS HELD AS TO WHERE THE SUNDAY MORNING SERVICE SHOULD BE HELD. POSSIBLY THE STANLEY THEATER WHERE A CHURCH ATMOSPHERE WOULD BE CREATED, OR POSSIBLY AT 3 OR 4 DOWNTOWN CHURCHES WHERE SERVICES WOULD BE HELD SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH ONE OF THE SERVICES ENTIRELY IN WELSH. THE COMMITTEE WILL CONSIDER THESE POSSIBILITIES.

**GYMANFA GANU:** [JEANNE JONES] PLANNING CONTINUES.

**NOSON LAWEN:** [JAY WILLIAMS JR.] THE MUNSON WILLIAMS PROCTOR INSTITUTE AUDITORIUM HAS BEEN SECURED FOR THURSDAY EVENING. DAFFYD IWAN HAS BEEN CONTACTED AND WOULD BE AVAILABLE FOR THAT EVENING. THE WELSH TOURIST BOARD WOULD PAY FOR THAT PERFORMANCE; THIS WOULD BE CLASSED AS A FOLK NIGHT. A DISCUSSION FOLLOWED AND IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT A FOLK PERFORMANCE MIGHT BE FOLLOWED BY A NOSON LAWEN WITH LOCAL TALENT SUCH AS BONNIE HIBBARD, GENE FALVO.

MANY OTHER SUGGESTIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED SUCH AS DARYL WILLIAMS ON VIOLA, TAPESTRY, GERAINT WILKES AS M.C. ETC.

JAY WILLIAMS JR. SUGGESTED THE NEED FOR A "P.R." COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE THE NATIONAL TO PEOPLE IN THIS AREA.

PAT DIVERS BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE COMMITTEE THE NEED FOR A LOGO AND THAT IT WAS ALSO NECESSARY TO PREPARE FOR A BOOTH AT THE 1995 NATIONAL AT HARRISBURG.
