REPORTS OF THE COMMITTEES:

LOGO: THE LOGO HAS BEEN REVISED AND THE AD SENT TO HARRISBURG. THE LOGO WILL BE IN THREE COLORS, RED, GREEN AND BLACK AND IS BEING PREPARED FOR OUR STATIONARY AND TEE SHIRTS.

CONCERT: IT WAS DECIDED NOT TO HAVE JASON HOWARD BECAUSE OF THE EXPENSE AND SCHEDULING CONFLICTS. MAIR LLOYD HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH A SOLOIST IN WALES AND THE COMMITTEE WILL MEET TO DISCUSS HER RECOMMENDATION. ELEANOR BENNETT HAS CONFIRMED THAT SHE WILL BE COMING.
