Irem Temple stewards are to handle the cookies and tea after the banquet.

Mr. Ben Davis will inquire about an extra room for the after banquet singing.

A newsletter informing people of times of bus transportation will be printed.

A place to store and freeze Welsh cookies has to be found.

Logos done by Mr. Saunders were discussed, it was decided to have Wilkes-Barre and "62nd Welsh Gymanfa Ganu" on this logo. This item to be discussed later.

We will have a page inside the Kansas City booklet advertising our Gymanfa Ganu and also a table with brochures advertising this Gymanfa.

Bob Anthony was asked to inquire about stickers to advertise our Gymanfa Ganu at Kansas City.
