Many thanks for your email and kind acceptance of our invitation.

We will contact you when we are about to purchase tickets and can discuss alternative arrangements then (we may or may not have a sponsorship arrangement). Having the Academi purchase the ticket and then reimbursing you is certainly an option.

We're asking for two presentations- both presented on Friday and then repeated on Saturday. There will be other programming at the time of the presentations and some people don't arrive until Saturday, so repeating the presentations gives people a chance to catch things they might miss on the first day. I know that Real Cardiff is your current project and I think our people would have some interest in a presentation on the city- I was thinking of a general presentation on Cardiff from an insider's perspective, perhaps with some material from your books to liven things up. However, we are flexible on the topics of the presentations and are willing to consider alternatives. Dear John

Thanks for yours. All this is dependant on me being able to get sponsorship locally for my travel costs. Let's look at two scenarios:

- 1) If I fail to gain financial support for my travel costs we will revert to our original agreement. WNGGA cover all Cardiff to Orlando travel, four nights at the hotel and access at no extra charge to all WNGGA weekend activities (with the exception of two of the three meals).
- 2) If I do get my travel costs covered WNGGA will pay me \$1000.00, cover four nights at the hotel, arrange Orlando to hotel and return transport (which I believe is free anyway), all access for my partner and I at no extra charge to all WNGGA weekend activities (with the exception of the final meal) but will cover both the Friday night and the Saturday meals. The Saturday meal on the assumption (as yet unconfirmed) that I will need to act as MC.

In any event I will be covering the event for Agenda as detailed in my last e-mail. My partner will be the photographer.

If the above is agreeable to you could you let me know.

I also have a further idea. I intend approaching the Cardiff Initiative (the Cardiff Tourist Board) to see if they might be willing to send out some complimentary material of Cardiff for distribution to delegates. They might also be willing to provide pull ups and other display material.

Could you let me know:

Approx number of delegates for the whole weekend (ie how many at Banquet)
Estimate of how many might be at my sessions
If DVD or PowerPoint displays are available.

Thanks John, nearly there

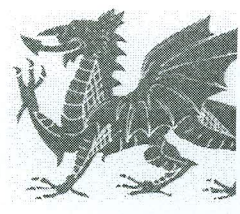

- 2 Complementary tickets to the concerts on Thursday and Friday


