Enclosed is a copy of the e-mail sent to Headquarters by Pat St. Clair plus a copy of her print out of the spread sheet. It arrived here on the screen as a spreadsheet but the lines didn't come through on the printer so I have added the lines to show the separate items.

The Hilton Hotel has sent a notice to us indicating a final payment of \$2,300 is needed to complete their payment. Enclosed with this memo to you, Huw, is a General Expense Voucher to pay that final bill since Harrisburg doesn't have any funds left in their checking account. I feel we should pay the hotel bill to preserve our credit rating.

In reading the print out, the column at the left is "Income" and at the right is "Expenses." Earlier I had indicated that we had retained \$10 per registration before the fees were sent on to Harrisburg. What Pat did was to record the total income of the registration fees and then listed as an expense what we retained.

This final report gives the totals for categories but not the detail. Huw has a copy of the checkbook register which Pat St. Clair has sent to us.

Question: How do you want to handle this? a) Simply file it away? b) Seek further information on the details of items with a view to better understand the amounts given for the categories.

There doesn't seem to be much leeway as far as recovering any funds. The balance of their checking account is less than \$100. However, the co-host is the Rehoboth Chapel.
