HOW TO ENTER THE EISTEDDFOD:

1. Complete the entry/request-for-information form on the reverse side, and return it to the address at the top of the form by **APRIL 15, 2001**.
2. Whether you are entering the Eisteddfod or requesting information you will be sent details of the event you indicate on the form by **APRIL 30, 2001**.
3. If you use the form as a request-for-information form, then your follow-up entry form must be received by **MAY 15, 2001**

SINGING COMPETITION:

Solo Voice: 2 contrasting pieces to be sung. At least one must be of Welsh origin. Total time allotted is 8 minutes.

Group Voices: 2 contrasting pieces to be sung. At least one must be of Welsh origin. Total time allotted is 12 minutes.

INSTRUMENTAL COMPETITION:

Two contrasting pieces to be played. At least one should have a Welsh flavor. Total time allotted for the presentation is 10 minutes.

LITERARY COMPETITION:

There will be 4 separate categories in the Literary competition. We will be judging Poetry and Prose in English and Welsh.

Prose Competition: For the prose competitions the limit is 1000 words. I'r gystadlaethau rhyddiaith, cyfyngir i 1000 o eiriau.

Poetry Competition: For the poetry competitions the limit is 50 lines. I'r gystadlaethau barddoniaeth, cyfyngir i 50 o linellau.

Translation (English /Welsh): A piece of 1000 words will be sent out to contestants as soon as their entry forms are received, but no later than **June 1**, for those entries received by **May 15, 2001**.

RECITATION

There will two pieces, one selected by the contestant and one selected by the judges. The judge selection will be sent out to contestants as soon as their entry forms are received, but no later than **June 1** for those entries received by **May 30, 2001**.
