Any cocktails purchased will be at the individuals own expense, which I'm sure will be many.

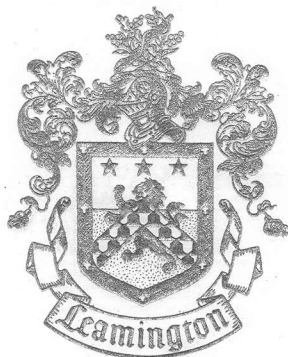
The hour for dinner will be 7:00.P.M..

We would be pleased to reserve a complete section of the Waikiki dining room for your Welch convention group on Thursday, August 31, 1978. The area could accommodate a maximum of seventy persons.

I am enclosing copies of the menus and assure you, there will be no increase in Waikiki prices.

As many of your group may not be totally familiar with Polynesian foods, may I acquaint you with the information that the four Combination Dinners listed on the front page, are our most popular items for groups in the Waikiki. According to our records, this is their sales status; #1 Shanghai Song - #2 Moon Festival - #3 Rice Harvest - #4 Canton Nights.

All these dinners include appetizers of Chinese Egg Roll, Puffed Shrimp, Waikiki Rumaki, Crab Rangoon and Barbecued Rib; also, Chinese Fried Rice, Special Blend Tea and dessert of Hawaiian Coconut Ice Cream with Fortune Cookie.

We advise that you limit the choice of the combination dinners preferably to one and never more than two which helps our kitchen in preparation time at the woks and our service staff in the dining room.

The tax is 7% and service charge of 15% added to the selected dinners. The food must be all on one check. Beverages can be on an individual basis and the liquor tax is 9% plus service charge.

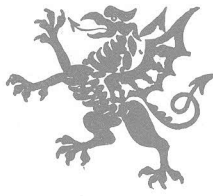

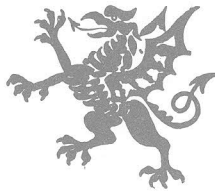
