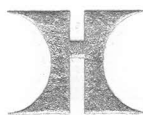

Portions of the above outlined facilities are under prior option. However, we feel confident that we can clear the space in question once a definite decision has been reached selecting the Niagara Hilton as your headquarter hotel.



Rates

Special group rates will be extended to your members, however, rates for 1979 will not be quoted until June of 1978. Our current range is:


I have received your housing form requesting a block of 50 rooms at the Niagara Hilton for August 30 - September 3, 1979.
