Dear Fellow Officers:

Jack has told me of your meeting next Saturday at Buffalo and he asked me "Would you have any ideas or suggestions to offer". The purpose of this meeting is to "finalize the program for the National".

First- I do not wish to suggest anything new in the beginning of the Sunday afternoon and evening Gymanfa Ganu sessions, and I suggest that the N.E.C. advise the Sponsoring Committee that the National President will call the meeting to Order and will call for the Singing of the National Anthems and the Invocation, after which he will introduce the President of the Session, who will then introduce the Chairman of the Session.

Second- it has been suggested many times that the word By be used thus: Introduction of President of Session by Mr. John G. - Roberts .

Third -if any new persons are slated for any part in the Gymanfa Sessions, and perhaps have never attended a Gymanfa Ganu, such persons should be reminded that three Thousand people have ment miles to sing and not to listen to Speeches.

The Hymnal Situation

Toronto 1967 used 700. Los Angeles had 600. So, we must have the next Run of 10 M. ready for before Buffalo. It will take the Printer about two months without rushing the job. So, he will have to begin about June 30.

Mr. Willard Holt the Printer, says, the men are not busy now, and he will take off \$50.00. of the price, if he could start now, and you will not have to pay right away.

The Printer will store the 10M hymnals, until they are all sold, as he is doing now.
