
Dear Emlyn:

I have been requested by Mr. Blanch to inform you that our negotiations with the Sheraton-Brock Hotel with regard to their accomodating the 1973 National have been unsuccessful. Our invitation to you to bring the National Gymanfa Ganu to Niagara Falls in 1973 is therefore withdrawn.

We have now been able to make suitable arrangements for the appropriate dates in 1973 with the Sheraton-Four Seasons in Toronto. On a tentative basis, rooms have been reserved for approximately 1800 delegates, and function rooms have been reserved for meetings and sessions, all of which are within the confines of the Hotel.

The Trustees of the O.G.G.A. will make their decision with regard to the move to Toronto by June 12th, and I am requesting you to postpone your deadline of June 15th for our reply to you until June 21st. I can assure you at this time that if we accept the Sheraton-Four Seasons, you will find that the Hotel is most suitable for our purposes.


Dear Emlyn:

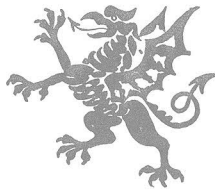


