Dear Emlyn:

I have been requested by Mr. Blanch to inform you that our negotiations with the Sheraton-Brock Hotel with regard to their accommodating the 1973 National have been unsuccesful. Our invitation to you to bring the National Gymanfa Ganu to Niagara Falls in 1973 is therefore withdrawn.

On a tentative basis, rooms have been reserved for approximately 1800 delegates, and function rooms have been reserved for meetings and sessions, all of which are within the confines of the Hotel.

I can assure you at this time that if we accept the Sheraton-Four Seasons, you will find that the Hotel is most suitable for our purposes.
