THANK YOU FOR YOUR LETTER OF THE 18th WHICH WAS RECIEVED ON 21st. IT HAS BEEN THE CUSTOM IN THE PAST THAT THE SPONSORING COMMITTE TO SUPPLY THE IDENTIFICATION AND LAPEL BADGES, SINCE WE DO NOT CARRY A SUPPLY FROM YEAR TO YEAR.

IF I MAY MAKE A SUGGESTION, THAT SINCE WE OF THE NORTH AMERICAN CONTINENT ARE TO BE GIVEN PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT IN THE SEATING ARRANGEMENTS BOTH AT THE GYMANFA GANU AND ON THE INVESTITURE ROUTE, THAT ONLY TWO DISTINCT COLOURS BE USED, ONE FOR THE TOURISTS FROM ABROAD AND THE OTHER FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE U.K. THAT WOULD TEND TO MAKE IDENTIFICATION VERY SIMPLE. THESE BADGES WOULD ONLY BE GIVEN OUT AT THE REGISTRATION DESKS, THERE BY ENTITLING THEM TO BE ADDMITTED FIRST IN THE GYMANFA ON SUNDAY.

THE COST OF REGISTRATION HAS BEEN ONE DOLLAR FOR MANY YEARS AT OUR NATIONALS, BUT THEN YOU USE YOUR OWN JUDGEMENT AS TO WHAT YOUR CHARGE WILL BE. I AM VERY HAPPY TO SAY THAT THE RESPONSE IS WONDERFUL, IN FACT WE IN THE YOUNGSTOWN AREA ARE OVER SOLD WITH THE AMOUNT OF SPACE THATH HAS BEEN ALLOCATED TO US AT THIS TIME. IT IS SAFE TO TELL YOU THAT WE WILL HAVE A MINIMUM OF 227 FROM THE YOUNGSTOWN AREA, 135 FROM THE PITTSBURG AREA, AND 167 FROM TORONTO CANADA.
