You will be notified by mail prior to the meeting, and if not, kindly check the bulletin board at the Headquarters Hotel.

Those of us who attended the two hour meeting of the Hymnal Committee last year know that we did well with our time and thoughts, and many fine ideas were expressed and discussed, also great valuable suggestions were made for the revision of the present hymnal. However, during our meeting, I the Chairman was called or summoned to the Executive meeting for a quick report on the hymnal project. I gave them some idea of what we had covered thus far. They gave me an ultimatum as to the deadline for the material as of January 1973, also an option was suggested of presenting four (4) supplimentary hymns to be used in Toronto for testing and evaluate

The time element definitely raised a question in my mind, and believe me I have given it much thought and prayer. When January 1973 was upon us-I contacted President Owen Roberts, and Secretary Jack Meadows about the matter. Both explained in detail that the National Association at this time is low of funds and is not able to undertake the project. We decided to accept the "option" four (4) supplimentary hymns as this would suffice the problem at this time.

The reason for my silence in not writing sooner is very obvious-that it would be waste of time and money to carry on with the project until we know for sure that there will be a financial support from the National. We can all be working individually on the project, and keep in touch in order to be ready when they give us a concrete "GO" signal. It will be interesting to pass on our ideas and ideas of other people to each other, especially the creative side of the project.

Thank you for your interest. Looking forward to seeing you at the National in Toronto if all will be well at that time.
