The constitution of the WELSH NATIONAL GYMANFA GANU ASSOCI-ATION "Article IV Legislative" reads in part "The Association shall be governed by the Board of Trustees".

It is therefore important that in the election of trustees great care should be given to the selection. As a WNGGA member in good standing it is YOUR RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE in this.

In the past nominations from the floor have been made and declined by the party named. This takes up much valuable meeting time unnecessarily.

A suggestion would be that you first consider all the aspects of a good trustee to represent you on the Board and especially whether this person is qualified and would accept the nomination.

The constitution reads in part: "No trustee shall be qualified for office unless and until it is determined that he has subscribed to the purpose of the association and has been a member of the association for a period of at least three years prior to the annual meeting at which such election takes place. -- Article IV Legislative".

The nominating committee has spent much time in making their recommendations, investigating very carefully the quality, knowledge and willingness of their choice. The future of the WNGGA is constantly foremost in their minds, and for your convenience they have pre-printed their choice of nominees with space for a write-in vote should you prefer.

We do hope that you will make every effort to attend the general meeting and lend your support — it is YOUR association. The Ontario Gymanfa Ganu Association have planned no other affair which would conflict with your attending YOUR general meeting.
