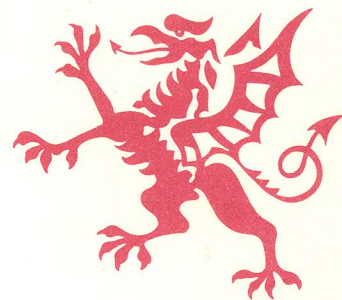

Dear Mr. Meadows,

Thank you very much for your letter of 21 March, and the copy of your letter to Mr. Cyril Rees of the same date.

I was very sorry to hear that there had been some misunderstanding over the nature of the inclusive rate packages offered by the Wales Tourist Board over the period of the Gymanfa Ganu and the National Eisteddfod in August 1974. I have checked our stocks of booking forms and I have found that, unfortunately, some of the booking forms (fortunately only a very small proportion) were printed without the words 'Gymanfa only' printed in the top left hand corner of the back of the form. You will see that the two price tabulations on the rear of the booking form refer to two separate inclusive tours; the first which is for the Gymanfa only, is for the period 1 - 5 August 1974 and the second which is for the Gymanfa, National Eisteddfod and Special Tours, covers the period 1 - 10 August.


I have mentioned the points raised in your letter to Cyril Rees to Mr. Lyn Howell who was, of course, very intimately concerned with the arrangements for the 1969 Gymanfa. He affirms that it is the tradition of the Local Organising Committee to extend complimentary hospitality to the National Officers of the WNGGA and this point will be made by him and myself to Mr. Cyril Rees. However, I am sure you will appreciate that I cannot comment on this matter until it has been discussed by the Local Committee.
