Dear Members:

Referring to our brochure on our Excursion Flights to visit the Gymanfa Ganu at Swansea, August 1-4'74, and the Royal National Eisteddfod at Carmarthen, August 8-9th, you may have wondered what the fuel crisis would do to our Charter Flights to London.

For a while, things looked extremely black, as BOAC canceled both our flights.

John Macree, thereupon, went to London to talk with BOAC at headquarters, and to Cardiff to discuss the matter with the Wales Tourist Board, enlisting their cooperation in persuading BOAC to reinstate our flights. But to no avail.

Fortunately, however, we have been able to secure similar dates with Pan Am, which we hope you will find acceptable.

Instead of Flight L-3, which was to leave on July 19, returning on Aug. 20 (33 days)
we offer you Thurs., July 18, returning Sat. Aug.17 (31 days)

Instead of Flight L-4, which was to leave on July 27, returning on Aug. 16 (21 days)
we offer you Sunday, July 28, returning Sat. Aug.17 (21 days)

No doubt you know already that all flight rates have gone up, and we consider ourselves fortunate that we can offer you the above reservations, per adult, at \$278.00, incl. departure tax;
children under 12 yrs. of age at time of departure, \$238.00, incl. departure tax;
infants under 2 yrs. of age at time of departure, \$ 30.50, incl. departure tax, no seat.

While this is more than the original assessment, at which time an increase was already anticipated, it still compares very favorably with the current individual excursion rates which are:

for the 14-21 day peak period at which we are flying, per adult, \$526.00 + \$3. tax = \$529.00
children under 12, as indicated above, \$263.00 + \$3. tax = \$266.00
infants under 2, as indicated above, \$ 52.60 + \$3. tax = \$ 55.60;
for the 22-45 day peak period, per adult \$413.00 + \$3. tax = \$416.00
children under 12, as indicated above, \$206.50 + \$3. tax = \$209.50
infants under 2, as indicated above, \$ 41.30 + \$3. tax = \$ 44.30.

We are sorry that on a charter flight the rates cannot be halved for children between 2 and 12 years of age at time of departure, but you will still realize a saving when combining adult with children's rates. Furthermore, the airlines intend to raise individual prices another 7% by April 15th.

If you have already submitted a deposit, please advise promptly if the above new arrangements and assessments are acceptable to you, indicating dates. If you have not yet sent in your application and wish to join, please submit application and deposit immediately.

In order to qualify for Charter Flight participation, you must have been a bona fide member of one of the sponsoring Welsh Societies for at least six months before flight departure. If you do not belong to any of these Societies, you may become a life-time member of the National Gymanfa Ganu Association of the United States and Canada by sending your one-time fee of \$10. to Mr. John Macree, 71 Vanderbilt Ave., New York, N. Y. 10017, who will submit your request for enrollment to the Association.

In order to maintain charter flight rates, we must have a Minimum Enrollment of 174. The number of children is restricted to ten (10) per Flight. If enrollment is below the required minimum, the respective Charter Flight will be converted into a Group Flight (minimum, forty full fares) at somewhat higher rates in conformity with official prices established by the Airlines under CAB regulations. We reserve the right to cancel any Flight should the necessity arise.

CANCELLATIONS: Up to thirty days before departure date, full refund will be made of payments made. If cancellation (for any reason) is received within thirty days from date of departure, refund can be made only if seat(s) can be sold to other eligible members.

IF OUR DATES do not suit you, our travel agent will assist you with reservations at Individual Excursion Rates (and with all your vacation flights and tour/hotel reservations, cruises, etc.)
