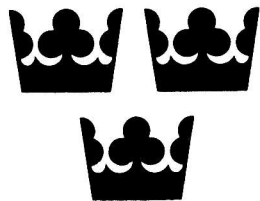
This coming weekend I will be in Scranton and will talk with Jack Pritchard about this. Will keep you posted.

PUBLICITY-NEWSPAPERS

Have first publicity ready to meet an August dateline with Y Ddrych and Ninnau. Try to get something in every issue thereafter.

PUBLICITY-OTHER WELSH ASSOCIATIONS

Liz asked him how many Welsh organizations existed around the North American continent. Ellis said about 45 (as I remember). Liz asked that the list be sent to her. We asked that all the names be sent, because it is our idea to also send publicity to each such organization throughout the year. Ellis said he would do as we asked. Musing, he said it was a very good idea; no one has done that before.

PNWGGA AND MEMBERSHIP IN THE NATIONAL

The discussion of Welsh organizations, above, came up after some explanations to Mr. Jones about PNWGGA and how it is doing a great deal towards building interest in things Welsh, leading to the formation of some and strengthening others. Ellis wondered if we could find it possible to add an invitation to join the national group to our own PNWGGA membership forms.

OPENING NATIONAL EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETINGS

A new departure will be tried at the national cymanfaoedd ganus. People from the local groups will be asked to sit in on some of the executive session meetings. Apparently this is for two reasons: it will help in the planning and carrying out of the cymanfaoedd, and it will allow input to the national committee by local groups.

PUBLICIZE THE AVAILABILITY OF SHOPPING AND SERVICES

We should be sure to put in our publicity, someplace, the information about the easy availability of shopping to those who come to Bellevue/Seattle. He thought our idea of giving some kind of a listing of shops etc within a two block radius of the headquarters hotel to be a good one.

Ellis is very concerned about WAY. They can not produce any kind of organizational document. They have no effective national organization, such as chapters in local areas, and rely heavily on local organizers to successfully bring off a WAY meeting. We will hear more about this, if we keep digging

- Nelson: Alan Upshall left a message Saturday night on my answering machine so I called him back late Sunday morning. Here is what we talked over:
1. Yes. they are planning to sell hymnals at their Puget Sound Booth inside the display area.
 2. Yes. they will be happy to sell the folk song books--the \$1 per book incentive is fine with him.
 3. Yes. I indicated that it was fine for the room charges for the WNGGA officers to be paid out of WNGGA share of proceeds.
 4. Yes. they will have a display table for WNGGA but it will not be in a secured area so only "information" items should on it.
 5. Yes. he is going to check on their list of volunteers to help with WNGGA table.
 6. Yes. he will arrange to have a podium, microphone, overhead projector, and screen for the Annual General Meeting.
 7. No. arrangements have not been made for a meeting of past, present, and future venue chairs; however, we could do so for 5:00 Saturday since Eisteddfod should be over by then.
 8. Yes. only the WNGGA Executive Committee and spouses will be invited to the Wales Tourist Board reception preceding the Banquet on Friday night. The number of places for the reception are quite limited.
 9. No. the NWAFF has not yet made arrangements for a display or for a reception even though they were included in the list of contacts.
 10. Yes. he will change my room reservations at the Hyatt from Wednesday-Tuesday to Thursday-Monday.
