28/73 Noson Lawen at Brangwyn Hall, Swansea on Saturday, 3 August 1974

The Secretary stated that the Noson Lawen Sub. Committee met on the 16 March last and appointed the Rev. T. Lloyd Evans as its Chairman.

Evans then proceeded to give the Sub. Committee's decisions as follows for this event.

Admission charge for local people	50p (30p for pensioners)
Compere	Mr. Alun Williams (BBC)
Artistes	Bois y Blacbord Bois y Beiro Cor Telyn Teilo Yr Awr Dewi Morris Glyn a Wendy Ellis (Excerpts from Under Milk Wood by Dylan Thomas).

The above recommendations were accepted with the exception of the admission charge.

On the suggestion of the Treasurer, it was agreed to defer this question until the cost of the artistes is known.

Mr. Glyn Alban Roberts thought we should have some idea by February next as to how many North Americans would be attending the various functions in Swansea.

#### 29/73 Patron

It was unanimously agreed to invite His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales to become Patron of the Festival, also that an invitation be extended to H.R.H. to attend the Banquet.

The following appointments were also made subject to acceptance.

<u>Vice Presidents</u>	The Chief Citizen of Swansea and The Chairman of the Welsh Council

#### 30/73 Hotel Accommodation for Officers of NGGA

The Secretary referred to a letter from Mr. Jack Meadows enquiring about Complimentary Accommodation for the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Recording Secretary, as was the case in Cardiff in 1969.

This matter was deferred pending a meeting between representatives of the Wales Tourist Board and Officers of the Swansea Committee, which Mr. G. Alban Roberts agreed to convene.

#### 31/73 Future Meetings

On the suggestion of Mr. Bryan Ladd it was agreed that future meetings be held on the second Monday in a month (not necessarily each month). The date of the first meeting is Monday, 11 June 1973.
